Escambia Children's Trust Wants to Hear from Local Providers

Pensacola, FL, August 5, 2022 – The Escambia Children's Trust wants to hear from local children and youth services providers throughout Escambia County. They will be "Passing the Mic to Providers" on Tuesday, August 16th, from 8 AM to 5 PM at the Pensacola State College Warrington Campus. The listening session is designed for community providers and leaders to share their insights from working directly with children. This event will be held in person and via Zoom for those who cannot physically attend. The Listening Session is broken up into the following four 2-hour segments based on the Trust's initial needs assessment.

- Healthy Children and Mothers (8 AM to 10 AM)
- Juvenile Justice-Involved Youth (10 AM to 12 PM)
- Child Abuse and Neglect (1 PM to 3 PM)
- Success in School and Life (3 PM to 5 PM)

Broad community input will help the Trust better understand the community's needs and opportunities for improving child outcomes. Providers, parents, and caregivers from all areas within Escambia County as well as public and private sector organizations, community leaders, pediatricians, faith groups, funders, etc. are invited to participate in the listening session.
