**Escambia Children's Trust Seeks Public Input  
On Proposed Children's Mental Health RFP**

*Pensacola, FL, May 3, 2023* – The Escambia Children's Trust is ramping up efforts to invest in the mental health and well-being of Escambia County children.

Today, the Trust published a draft Request for Proposals (RFP) and launched a public comment portal so that people can provide feedback on the new solicitation, which is aimed at increasing mental health support for children, youth, and families.

“May is Mental Health Awareness Month, and this week is Children's Mental Health Awareness Week,” said Tammy Greer, ECT executive director. “There is no better time than now to release this new RFP to the community, and get input from parents, families, providers, community leaders, and those struggling to find the help they need, so that we can make the final document the best it can be.”

The draft RFP, entitled “Community-Led and Community-Operated Mental Health Supports for Children and Families,” is open for public feedback through May 31, 2023. All comments submitted via the online portal will become part of the public record and will be used to refine the final RFP before it is released to proposers in June 2023.
